Academics:

The year 2024 commenced on a wonderful note when the results of our class 10 came out. We are happy to share with the details of the commendable performances of our students.

Continuing with the tradition of 100% result for almost two decades, this year too, all our 121 students of class X who appeared for the 2023-24 SSE examination, passed in flying colours. Syeda Ruqauya stood first with 94.4% marks. Srinidhi B and R Vijita stood second and third with 93.6 and 93.2% marks respectively. 34 students got 80% and above. 91 students out of 121 got 60% and above. I congratulate all our previous batch for their spectacular victory.

Excellence in academics is the hallmark of any good institution and class 10 results of the school prove beyond any doubt that our students made us proud. None of these achievements would have been possible without the single minded commitment and dedicated effort of our teachers. We are also constantly encouraged by parents and well-wishers who have shown

much confidence and given their fullest support. I wish to acknowledge the efforts and guidance of our management as their collaboration and contributions have made a difference.
