

# Curriculum

The school is affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education (C.B.S.E.), Delhi and therefore follows the syllabi prescribed by the Board. The medium of instruction is ENGLISH. The curriculum at Baden Powell Public School is well structured and is in sync with National Education Policy 2020 at all the levels to equip the students with 21st century skills. Students enjoy a well-rounded educational program which is innovative, flexible and incorporates the rigor and academic quality. The school curriculum is designed to offer a comprehensive educational experience. It includes core subjects such as Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and Languages. The curriculum is structured into three levels:

## **Pre Primary Stage (Pre KG to UKG)**

### **Primary Stage (Classes 1-5)**

### **Secondary Stage (Classes 6-10)**

Each stage has a specific focus, building on knowledge and skills progressively.

#### **Pre Primary Stage**

Learning as an ongoing, wholesome process will be evaluated in a continuous and comprehensive manner. The comprehensive Assessment process, at this stage, focuses on the daily, consistent progress made by the child in academic as well as co-curricular activities.

The assessment procedure is based on the child's daily interaction in the class, his/her levels of general awareness, the quality of work produced by him/her, internalisation of the concepts taught during the course of classroom interaction and the consequent learning outcomes throughout the year.

The progress Profile of the students will be sent twice in a year. Certificates are awarded to the students for meritorious performance in various areas of achievement.

#### **Primary Stage**

In the primary stage, students focus on foundational subjects like English, Kannada, Hindi, Mathematics, and Environmental Studies.

Besides these major subjects, computer science, Art Education, General Knowledge and Physical Education are also taught.

The academic year is divided into two halves; Term I and Term II. Term I examination is conducted in the month of September from the syllabus completed till then which is almost 50% of the entire syllabus for the year. Periodic tests are conducted thrice in a year.

Parent Teacher Meetings to declare the results of the examinations are conducted after every examination. Co-curricular activities and intra school competitions are conducted and the winners are motivated with prizes and certificates.

#### **Secondary Stage**

In the Secondary stage, students focus on subjects like English, Kannada, Hindi, Mathematics, and Social Science.

Besides these major subjects, computer science, Art Education, General Knowledge and Physical Education are also taught.

They are also given an option to choose between Sanskrit and Hindi at this stage as the third language.

In grades IX and X, an additional vocational subject named artificial intelligence is also taught.

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### **Pedagogical Approach**

The school curriculum emphasizes a student-centered approach to learning. This means teaching methods are designed to engage students actively, encouraging critical thinking and problem-solving. The curriculum also integrates practical experiences and project-based learning to make education more interactive and relevant.
